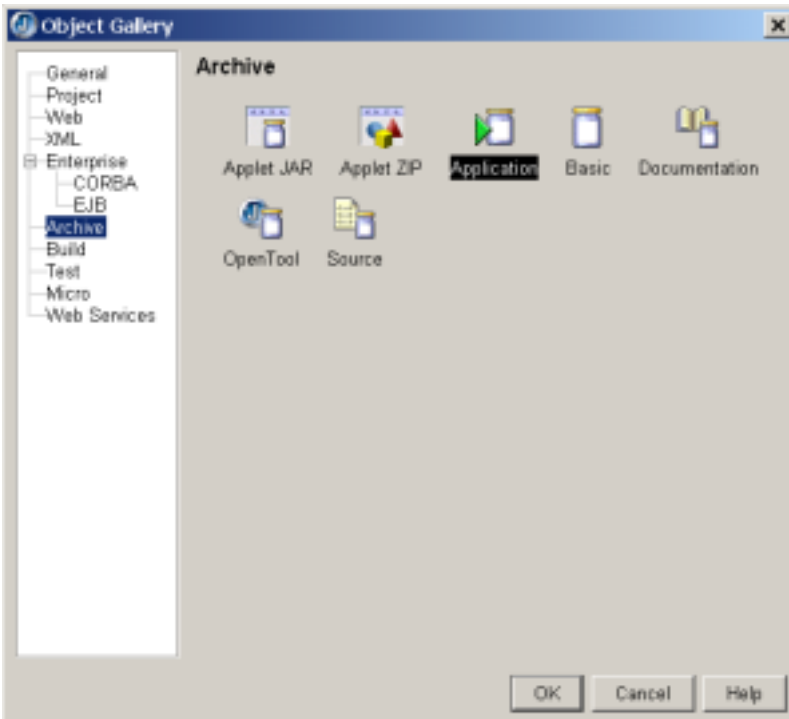


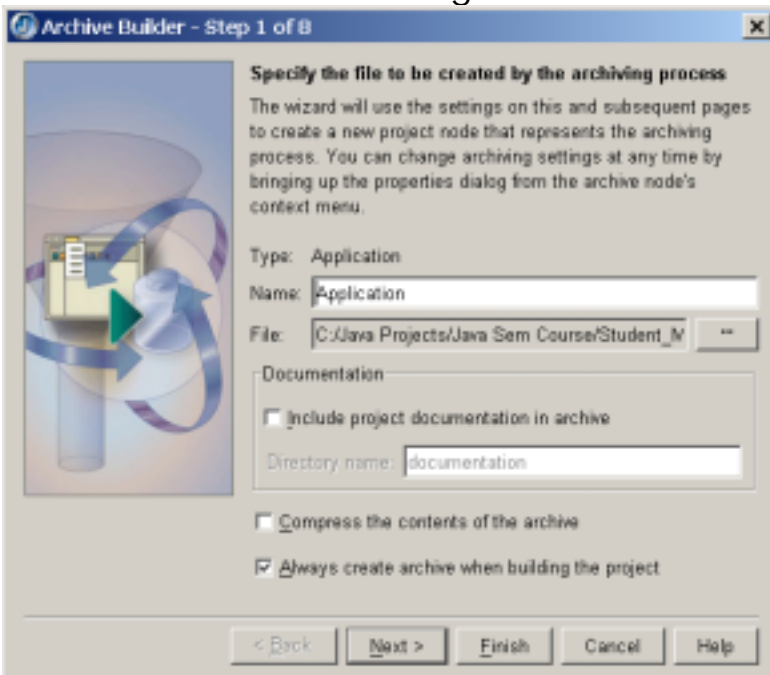
# How to create a jar file for your program ver 1.0 by Mr. Hanley

For an application,

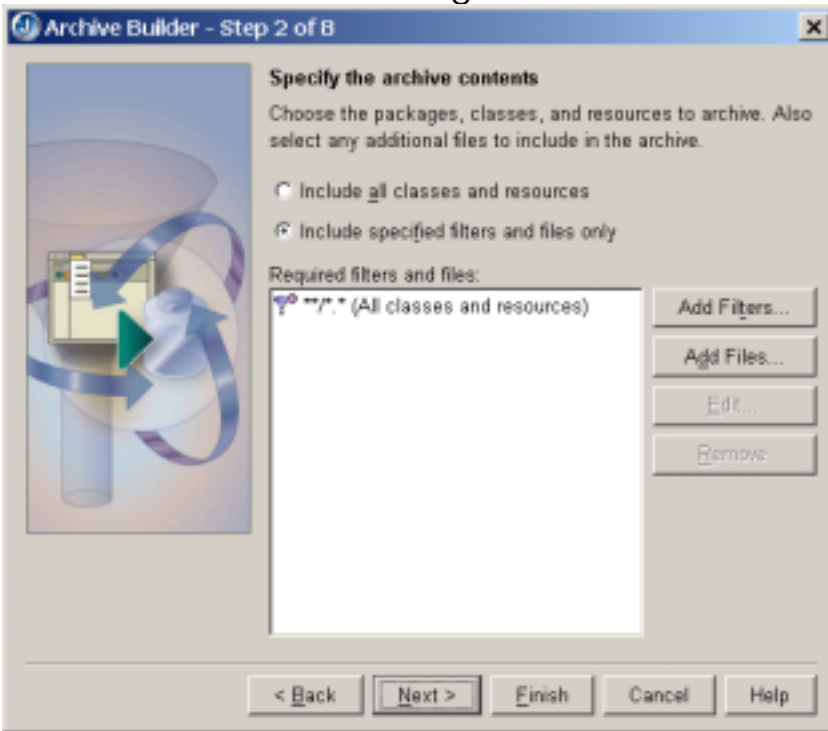
Choose File...New...Application



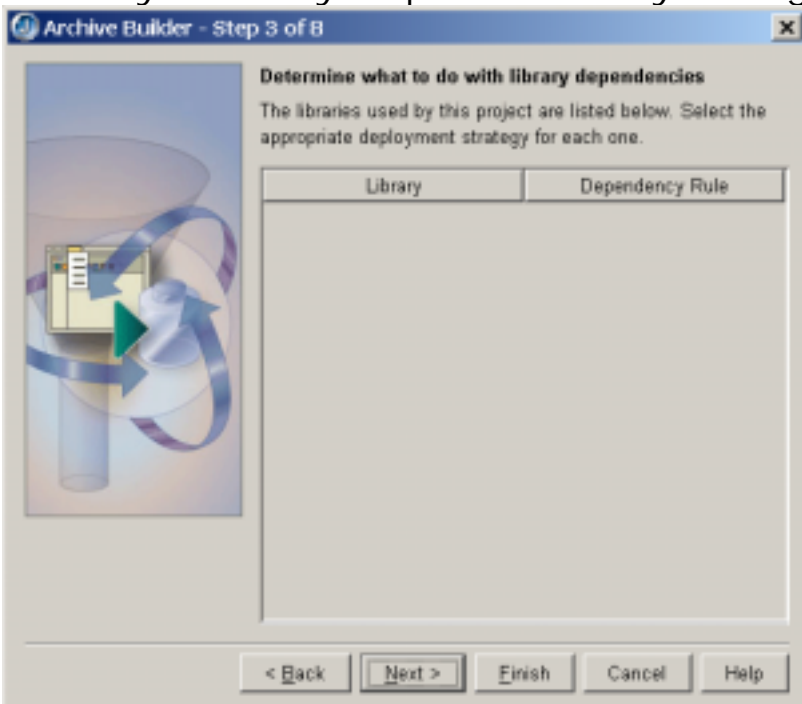
Leave the next dialog in defaults



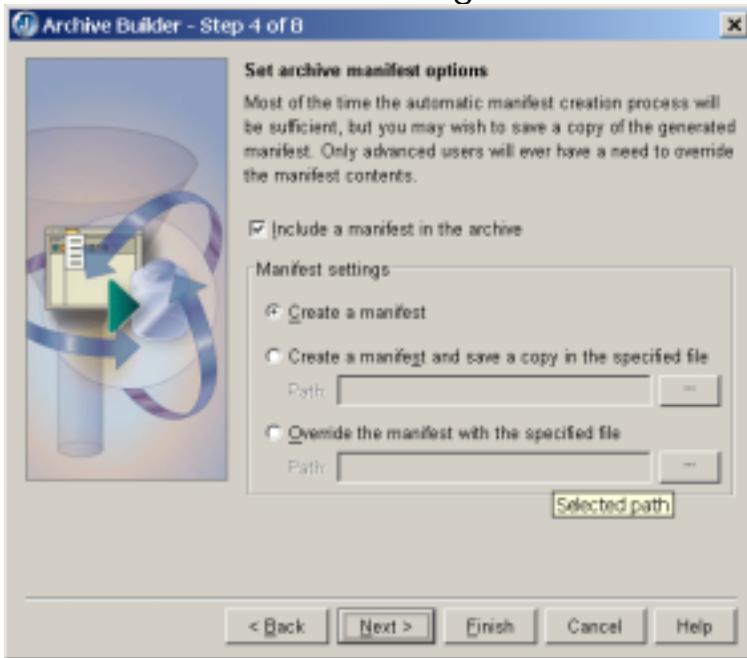
Leave the next dialog with defaults



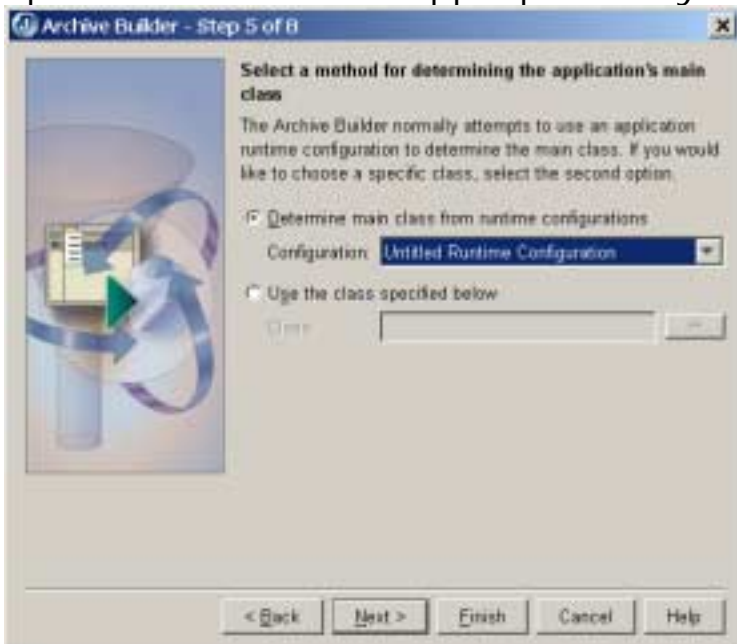
Add any library dependencies you might have



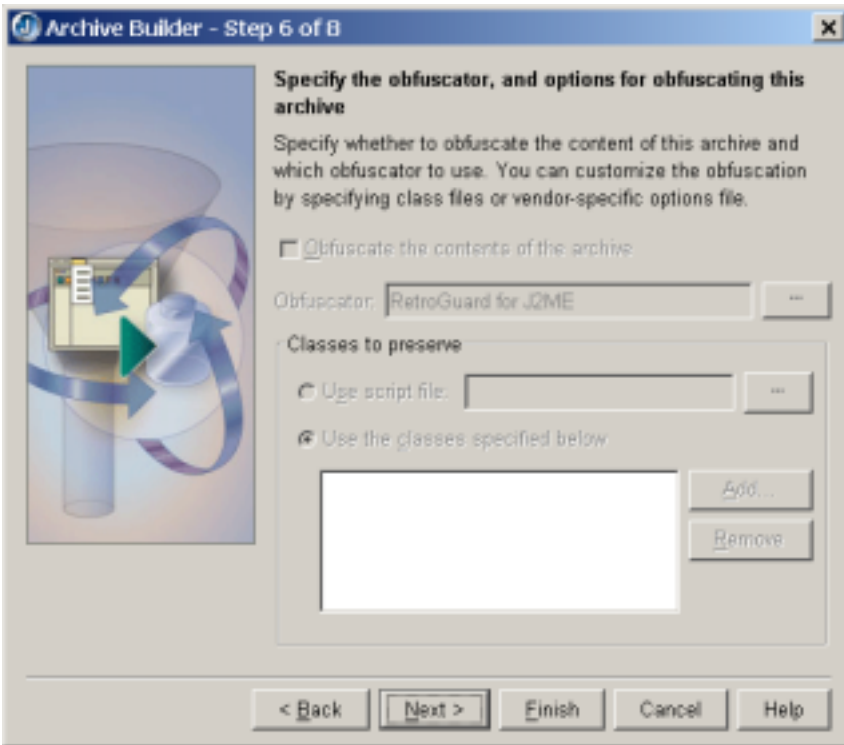
Leave the next dialog in defaults



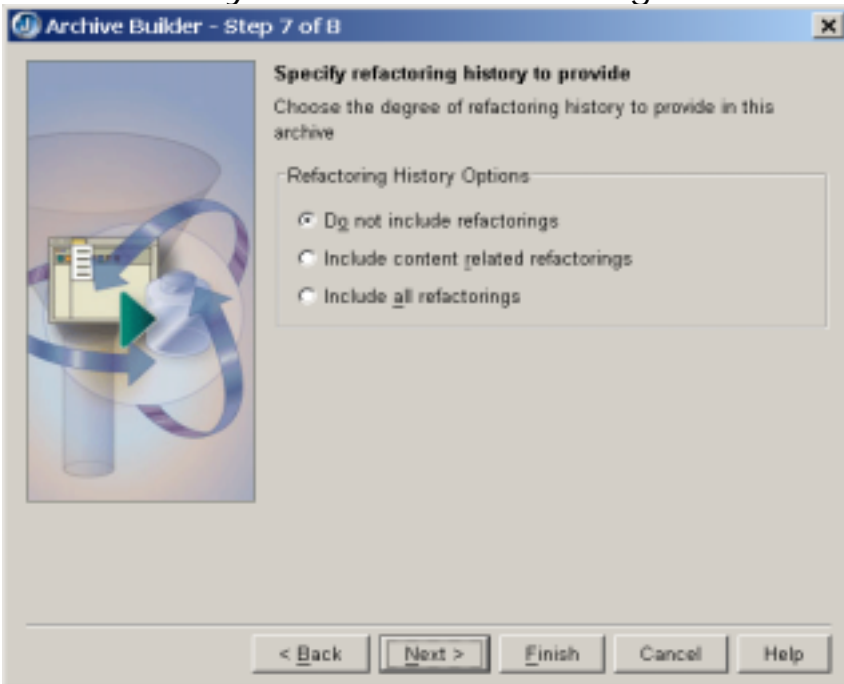
Select the Untitled Runtime Configuration (make sure you have set up the main class appropriately before doing this!)



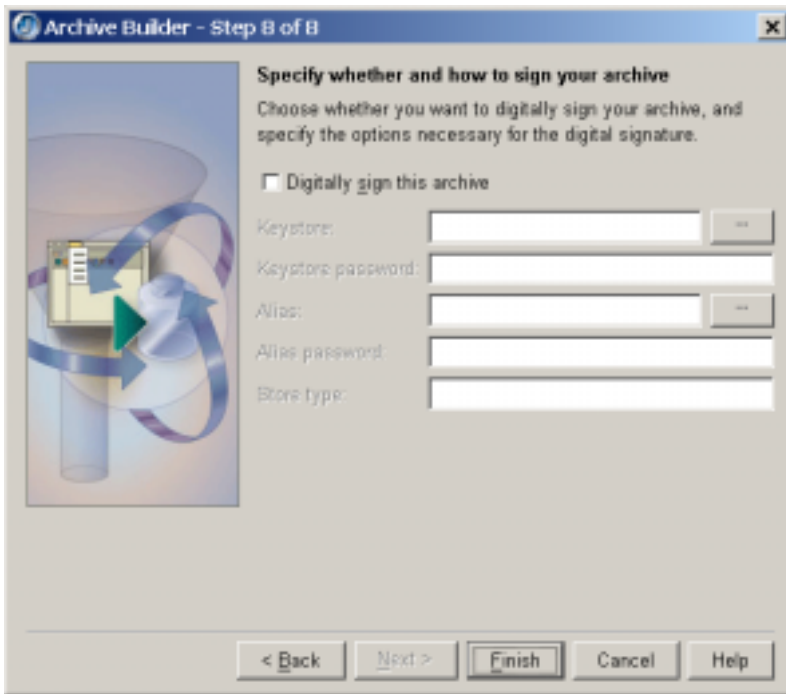
Don't use the code obfuscator



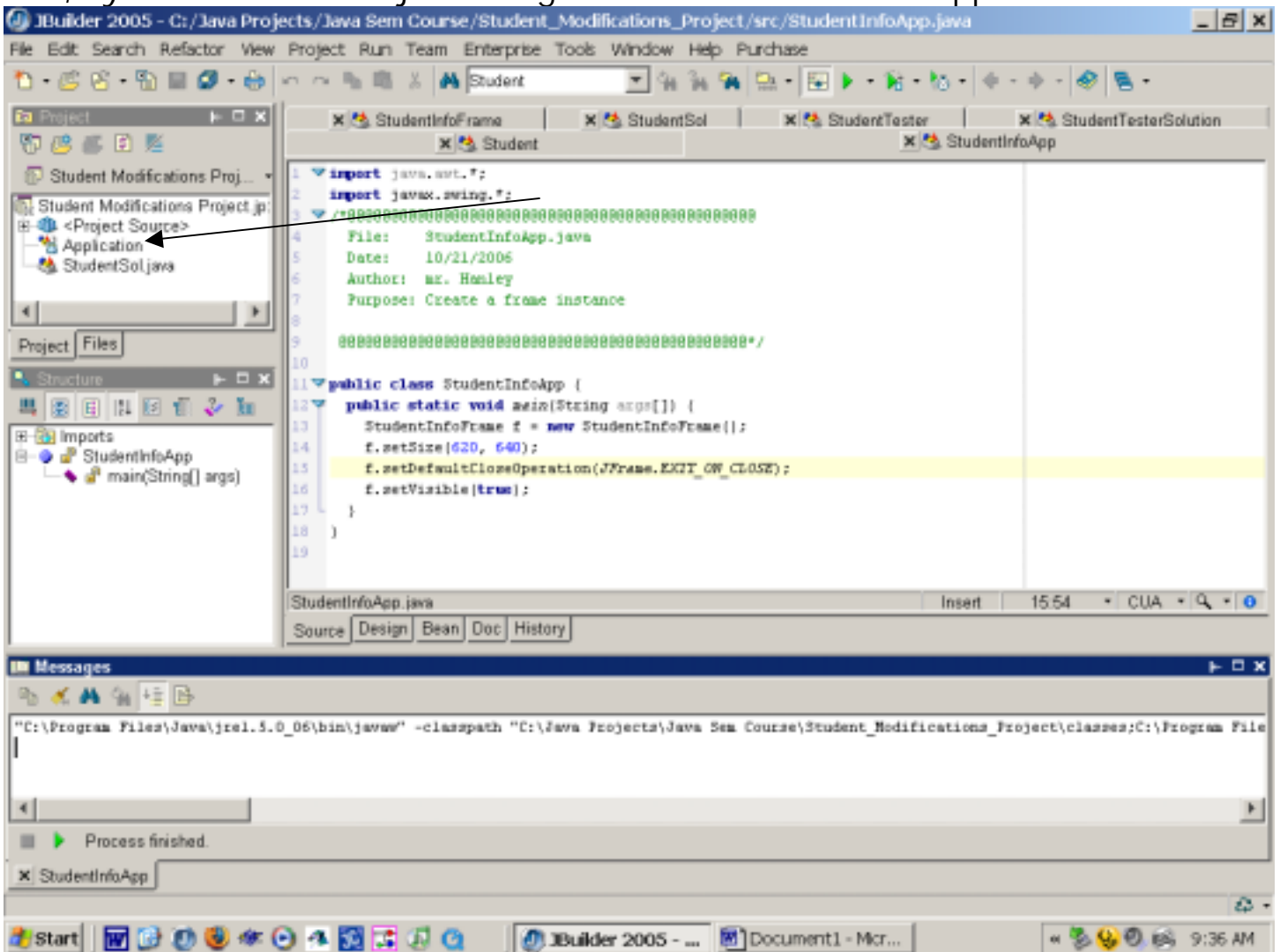
Don't worry about refactoring



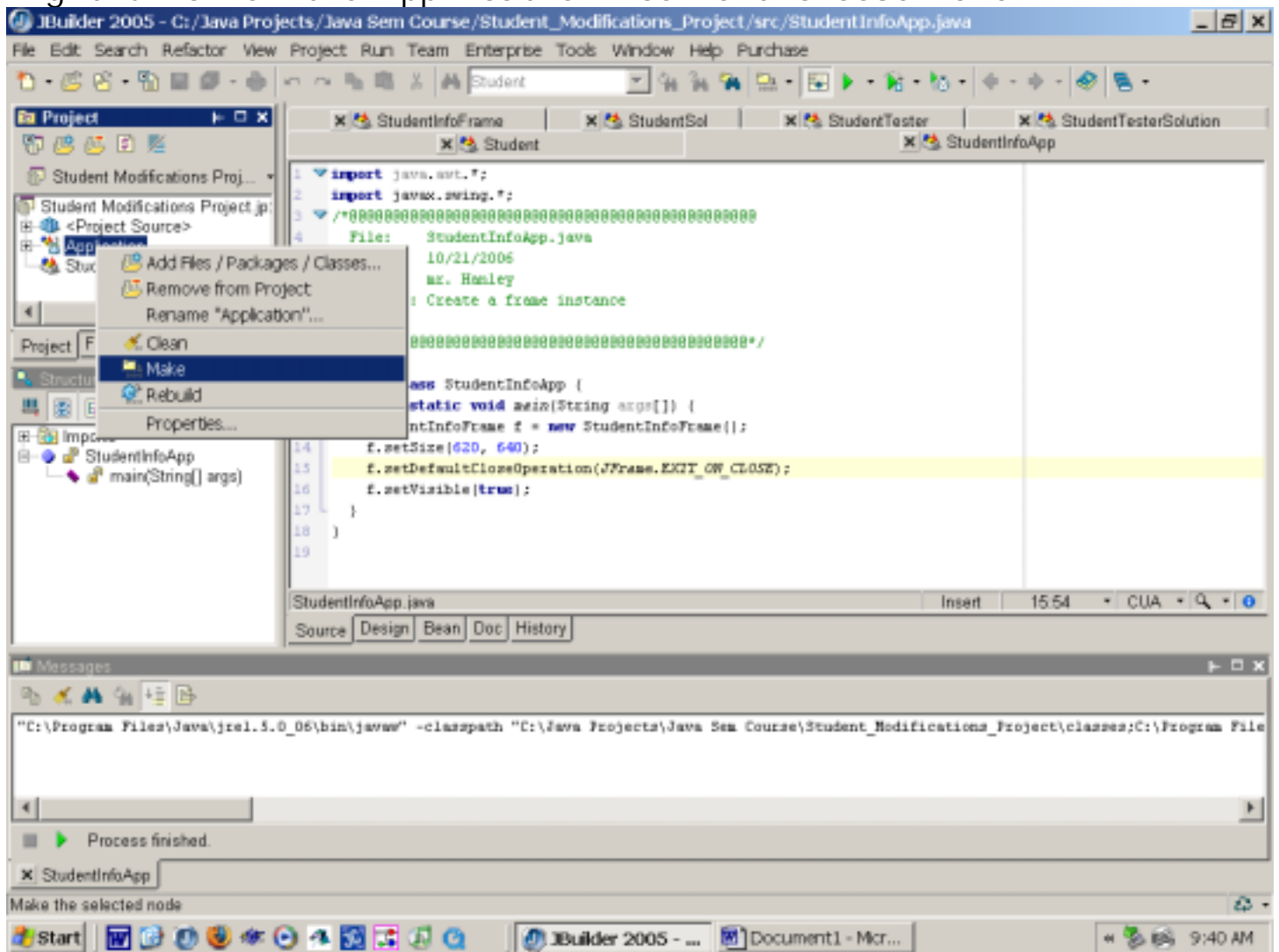
Don't worry about signing your application



Now, you will see a jar image next to the word Application



Right Click on the Application icon and choose Make



Now you can copy this .jar file to a floppy, CD or mail it to someone.

As long as they have the correct Java Runtime Libraries on their computer, they should be able to execute your program.
