Welcome to Third Grade! I am looking forward to working with your child this school year.

It is hoped that you will find the following information regarding the beginning of the school year helpful.

### **Take Home Folders**

Each day students will bring home a folder. This folder is to go back and forth each day. It will contain notes from school and completed work. Some days it may be empty. Please review it each day and return any notices that are marked to bring back to school. The folder will also include a calendar which will be marked each day with a “G” for green, “Y” for yellow, or “R” for red. This is to inform you on what kind of day your child had. Green means a great day, yellow a couple of reminders to stay on task, and red- a tough day. Please check your child’s calendar each night.

### **Messages**

Please put all important messages in an envelope clearly marked with your child’s name, to whom it is for, and what it is for. ### **Absences**

Please send a note on the day of your child’s return, stating the date, name, and reason for absence- along with your signature.

### **Book Clubs**

Children are encouraged to bring a small nutritious snack from home each day. Please make sure it is **peanut** free.

### **Birthdays**

Birthday treats are welcome, if easily served, but are not necessary. Also, please send some napkins too. A day’s notice so we can fit it into our schedule would be appreciated.
