

Student Expectations for Fourth Grade Assignments

Please read and discuss these expectations with your child.

In order to be successful in fourth grade, it is important for our students to become responsible and independent learners.

With this in mind, each week fourth graders will have the opportunity to participate in Friday Club. Depending on their completion of the week's classwork and homework, they will be assigned to Skills Club or be given the opportunity to participate in a Friday Club Activity.

If an assignment is not prepared for the day it is due, it is considered a "missed assignment." This rule applies for math class as well as homeroom assignments.

If you miss one assignment

- ★ Make up your assignment and show your teacher before Friday.
- ★ You still have the choice to participate in a Friday Club activity.

If you miss two or more assignments

- ★ You will be expected to participate in Skills Club during Friday Club time.
- ★ In the Skills Club, students, with the support of an adult, are expected to work quietly on missed assignments, read, write, or work on math facts.

Other ways to join the Skills Club

- ★ Any student who would like to, may *choose* to join the Skills Club.
- ★ If a student has been struggling in a given subject, a teacher may instruct him/her to report to the Skills Club, even if the student has not missed two or more assignments.
