

Mrs. Michelucci's Token Behavior Management System - Grade 1

What is it?

All 1st grade Language Concepts students will be working to earn 5 tickets per day. This type of behavior management is a very positive and visual way for the children to monitor their own behavior and take responsibility as a member of our classroom community.

How will my child earn tickets while in Language Concepts?

- Making good choices & displaying good behavior
- Participating during class lessons/groups/activities
- Completing work that is given
- Being responsible

Can tickets be taken away?

Yes, if your child is:

- Making poor choices
- Not getting along with classmates
- Not participating during a lesson or group work
- Not following directions
- Not completing work that is required

All children are given a warning and several choices they can make to help them change their behavior before they will be asked to remove a ticket from their bucket.

What happens if my child earns their 5 tickets?

- If your child earns 5 tickets, they will receive a "star punch" on their Good Behavior card and receive a reward (sticker, candy, extra playtime, etc) for that day.
- After 5 punches on their card, your child will be able to visit the "Treasure Lion"!! He is full of rewards and is waiting for your child to visit!
- We also have FUN FRIDAY!! If your child receives at least 3 punches in their card during the week, they may participate in Fun Friday. We may go outside, play a group game, etc. so it is definitely something the children like to work towards!

What happens if my child does not earn enough "star punches" to participate in "Fun Friday"?

- We talk about ways we can do a better job
- Think of good choices to make if a certain situation arises again
- A child not earning "Fun Friday" will sit quietly at one of the small round tables in our classroom during the particular activity.

Tracking Sheets

You will find a weekly "Ticket Tracker!" sheet in your child's YELLOW Language Concepts folders. A check will be given if your child received their "star punch" and an X will be used to indicate no reward was given on that day. If a reward is not given, I will often include a quick explanation as to why. You and your child can then discuss it at home if you would like to.
