“JUNIOR CITIZENSHIP PASS”

Juniors who meet ALL of the criteria listed below are eligible to receive a “citizenship pass” during the applicable school quarter.

Students and parents must complete applicable parts of the document. Next, the student must make an appointment with his/her Class Assistant Principal for verification and approval.

CRITERIA:

1. A student must achieve a grade of 85% or higher in each course during the previous marking period (REPORT CARD). However, consideration will be given for one course grade between 80-85%.
2. A student must receive a 1 or 2 in effort and conduct in each class during the previous marking period (REPORT CARD).
3. Students are expected to attend school and be on time to school and classes. During the previous marking period, **DO NOT EXCEED:**
 - a. 5 unexcused tardies to school per quarter.
 - b. A total of 5 unexcused tardies to class per quarter.
 - c. Students may not have more than 1 Unexcused absence from class or school.
4. **Student Code of Conduct:** Students are expected to exhibit school citizenship by following the rules of the school. For the previous quarter, **DO NOT:**
 - a. Cut any classes.
 - b. Commit a level II, III, or IV infraction. Level 1 infractions are at the discretion of the Class Assistant Principal.
5. Students may not have any outstanding library/media materials (LIBRARY STAMP REQUIRED).
