

# Four candidates vie for two seats on school board

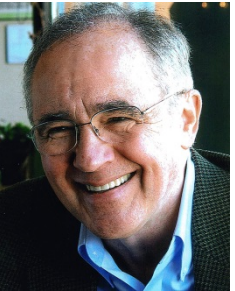
The following candidates submitted petitions with the required 52 signatures to run. They are listed in the order that they will appear on the ballot.
