APPLIED MUSIC PACKET 2018-2019 School Year Regulations governing credit for Applied Music

Students enrolled in the Shenendehowa Central School District in grades 9-12 may earn onehalf credit for private applied music instruction by meeting the following criteria:

- Form A must be completed in full and returned to Mr. Frank Rosselli, Academic Administrator for Fine & Performing Arts, no later than October 5th.
- 2. Credit may only be awarded for study on instruments that are not available for instruction within the school program (*Including but not limited to: Piano & Guitar*).
- 3. The student must attend a weekly lesson for a minimum of thirty minutes resulting in at least thirtysix lessons by the close of the fourth quarter.
- 4. The student must practice a minimum of five hours per week and maintain their practice record including a parent signature on **Form B**.
- At the close of each quarter the student should return <u>Form B and Form C</u> (please make copies as needed), which is to be completed by the private lesson instructor. *GRADES MUST BE NUMERICAL* (0-100). <u>The due dates for these two forms are as follows:</u>

4 th	Quarter -**	June 12, 2019
3 rd	Quarter -	April 1, 2019
2 nd	Quarter -	January 18, 2019
1 st	Quarter -	November 2, 2018

****For the 4th quarter**, in addition to Forms B & C, the student must also return the final course evaluation as prepared by their private lesson instructor – **Form D.** This additional form will represent the student's final culminating examination which the student must pass to receive final credit.

Failure to complete and submit forms as required by their due dates may result in the student being dismissed from the applied music credit program.

Credit for applied music study is not applicable to a regents or local diploma. Applied credit can only be used for elective credit and does not fulfill or count towards the one music credit required for graduation. Additionally, grades for applied music credit are not factored into the student's quarter and/or final average.
