Grade 3-8 Testing & NYSESLAT K-12 - Per the NYSED the following New York State Testing Programs have been suspended for the remainder of the school year:

- New York State Grades 3-8 English Language Arts Test;
- New York State Grades 3-8 Mathematics Test;
- New York State Grade 4 Elementary-Level Science Test;
- New York State Grade 8 Intermediate-Level Science Test;
- New York State Alternate Assessment (NYSAA) for students with severe cognitive disabilities in Grades 3-8 and high school;
- New York State English as a Second Language Achievement Test (NYSESLAT)

Advanced Placement Exams - information provided by The College Board:

- NO face to face exams will be given for 2020 AP courses/exams.
- Students will be given a shortened AP exam electronically/online directly from the College Board (45 minutes). They will still be able to earn college credit.
- Exams are currently being revised to cover only curriculum typically covered through early March of the school year (see College Board website for curriculum specifics for each course).
- Students will be able to choose from two test dates, one early for those who want to test while material is fresh, and one later for those who want more time to prepare.
- Test dates, more particulars about exam content, and details for the online testing process will be released by April 3 on the College Board website.
