Class Placement Notification

Our goal is to send teacher information home regarding class placements during the week of September 8th.

- Students will have a homeroom teacher
- All students will receive instruction from a certified teacher
- Teachers at each grade level will collaborate to best meet the core academic needs of students- Math, Science, ELA, & Social Studies during the course of each day.



Elementary Schedule

- The opening weeks of school will continue to reintroduce students to classroom practices for both safety (e.g., wearing masks, washing hands) and learning
- This year we will spend extra time evaluating the needs of students and helping them acclimate to the school setting for academics and social/emotional needs.
- Students will be receiving instruction in ELA, math, social studies and science.

Elementary Daily Supplies and Student Belongings

- Basic grade level supply list have been provided on the district website.
- Parents may receive additions to the supply list when the year begins.
- We recognize this year is very different, therefore we will limit the purchase of additional items.
- Some schools have cubbies and they will not be used to start the year. Other schools have hook systems in hallways that can be used in socially distant ways
- Students can also place their coats and backpacks on the back of their chairs



Elementary Lunch and Recess

- Lunches purchased through the school will be delivered to the classrooms.
 - Classrooms with students that have food allergies will be addressed on a class by class basis and we will ask for families within the classroom to help support specific situations as needed
 - Students who bring lunch can buy milk have it delivered to the classroom
- Recess will remain a part of the elementary school day.
 - We are working on games and activities that can be fun for the students and yet still promote social distancing.



Elementary Special Education

- > IEPs will be followed
- Some time allocations for consultant, coteach and special class may be reduced due to shortened school day
- Resource room and therapies will take place in smaller locations per IEP
- Staff has access to additional PPE as needed

Daily Supplies and Student Belongings

- Basic grade-evel supply lists have been provided on the district website.
- As is the case from past years, you may receive some additions to the supply list when the year begins.
- We recognize that this year is very different, so we are looking to limit the purchase of additional items.
- We may be asking for families to purchase some items to make sure we can limit the sharing of supplies.
- Students will not be using their lockers until further notice
- Students will keep their belongings throughout the day in a small backpack or cinch bag
- Students will place their coats and backpacks on the back of their chairs

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Breakfast

- Breakfast will be available to students
- Students will need to go immediately to their cafeteria upon exiting their bus
- Social distancing requirements will be upheld

Lunch

- Students will be ordering their lunch via a Google Form in their Advisory class each morning
- Students will be eating lunch in the cafeteria or classroom
- Social distancing requirements will be upheld

Masks

- Need to be worn by all stakeholders at all times except during mask breaks or while eating
- Mask breaks will be given at the direction of the teachers/monitors



Middle School Special Education

- Services will be provided in conjunction with the block schedule
 - Ex: If a student has Integrated Co-teaching 5x40/week on their IEP, the student will now receive Integrated co-teaching for 64 minutes in school, every 4th day and receive synchronous and asynchronous instruction when not in person
- Resource room will be provided as delineated above AND students will be invited to google meets for additional support when they are not in-person
- > Students attending the FSD program will attend daily
- Staff will have access to additional PPE to support small group instruction

A Student Day

- Arrival and report to 1st class / Dismissal
 - Advisory/Homeroom
 - No locker use to start
 - Breakfast grab and go
 - Late arrival and early release for some students
- Transition between Class
 - Staggered where appropriate, One way halls, Masks are to be worn
- Lunch
 - Lunch periods are 40 min, primarily in classrooms
 - Grab and go
- Instruction
 - In-person and remote expectations for learning in both environments
 - CVL instruction
- Extra-Curricular
 - Virtual where possible and encouraged



High School Special Education

- Services will be provided in conjunction with the block schedule
 - Ex: If a student has Integrated Coteaching 5x40/week, the student will now receive Integrated coteaching for 78 minutes in school, and receive synchronous and asynchronous instruction when not in person
- Resource room will be provided as delineated above AND students will be invited to google meets for additional support when they are not in-person
- > Students in the FSD and MOVE programs will attend daily
- > Staff will have access to additional PPE to support small group instruction
