WHEN/WHERE TO VOTE

Who can vote?

- You are eligible to vote if you are: a U.S. citizen, 18 years or older and have been a Shenendehowa district resident for at least 30 days prior to the vote
- No pre-registration is required
- Official personal photo identification is required



CAN'T GET TO THE POLLS?

Absentee ballots may be used by any resident who will not be available to come to the campus to vote. They are available at the District Office, 5 Chelsea Place, Clifton Park. For information. call the District Clerk at 881-0623. By law, absentee ballots are mailed to any resident who is certified by Saratoga County as disabled. If you are disabled and did not receive an absentee ballot, please call the District Clerk's office. Ballots must be returned to the District Clerk no later than 5 pm on May 20.
